

City of Baker School Board Meeting August 7, 2018

MINUTES

The City of Baker School Board held a public meeting in the Board Room of the City of Baker School Board Office beginning at 6:00 p.m. on August 7, 2018.

Dr. Dana Carpenter, Board President, called the meeting to order.

A moment of silent meditation was led by Mrs. Davis, followed by the Pledge of Allegiance led by Mr. Dees. Dr. Carpenter welcomed all visitors to the meeting.

On motion of Mrs. Johnson seconded by Mr. Dees, the Board voted to approve the agenda. Mrs. Johnson then amended the motion to add "Consideration and Approval of Lease Agreement with Ross Bus and Equipment Sales, Inc." as Agenda Item #16.1. The motion was seconded by Mr. Dees. Voting yes: Carpenter, Davis, Boxie, Dees and Johnson. Voting no: None. The amended motion passed.

Senator Regina Barrow made a presentation of a chrome book and printer to Kelly Thomas, a tenth-grade student at Baker High School. Mr. Thomas was unable to attend the meeting so Ms. Iris Walker, Special Education Supervisor, accepted on his behalf and will make arrangements to get the chrome book and printer to him.

The Board and Superintendent Brister recognized Senator Regina Barrow and Representative Barbara Carpenter for their help in making the 2018 "Back-to-School Expo" such a tremendous success. They were each presented with a Medallion of Achievement.

On motion of Mr. Dees seconded by Mrs. Johnson, the Board voted to approve a memorandum of understanding between Louisiana State University (LSU), College of Human Sciences & Education, School of Education and the City of Baker School System relative to the assignment and supervision of LSU teacher candidates. On motion of Mrs. Davis seconded by Mrs. Johnson, the Board voted to approve a contract with Dr. Stephen Zafirau, Number 2 Pencil Consulting, to build and implement an effective system for tracking student data at Baker High School. On motion of Mrs. Davis seconded by Mrs. Boxie, the Board voted to approve the addendum to the 2018-2019 City of Baker School System *Pupil Progression Plan*. Voting yes: Carpenter, Davis, Boxie, Dees and Johnson. Voting no: None.

On motion of Mrs. Davis seconded by Mrs. Boxie, the Board voted to approve a lease agreement with Ross Bus Sales and Equipment, Inc. effective July 1, 2018 through June 30, 2023. Voting yes: Carpenter, Davis, Boxie, Dees and Johnson. Voting no: None.

Superintendent Brister made the following announcements/remarks:

- 5. Superintendent Brister introduced Dr. Kimberly LeSage, the District's new Supervisor of Accountability, Assessment and Evaluation, to the Board and the audience.
